



REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL – ROUNDHOUSE MODIFICATIONS (CNG)

The Indiana Harbor Belt Railroad (IHB) is soliciting design-build construction proposals for the modification of its roundhouse in Hammond, IN. These modifications are necessary for the compliant maintenance of compressed natural gas (CNG) powered locomotives. This project involves federal funds and as such, is subject to all requirements for federally funded projects.

Qualified proposers shall demonstrate experience in design build projects of this nature in the Chicagoland area and must possess the related intimate code and compliance expertise. Proposers shall demonstrate their ability to evaluate existing facilities for the identification and efficient mitigation of noncompliant elements and to extend traditional application of the codes to this unique facility.
